CHA is pleased to provide the "California Hospital Emergency Food Supply Planning Guidance and Toolkit". This resource is the culmination of work completed by the California Hospital Association's Hospital Preparedness Program (CHA-HPP) through a Hospital Emergency Food Advisory Group which included representation from the California Dietetic Association, Hospital Nutrition Managers and Directors, and Hospital Emergency Preparedness Coordinators.

This toolkit is intended to provide guidance and resources to hospitals in planning for and documenting emergency food supplies as mandated by regulatory requirements.

The newly released toolkit "California Hospital Emergency Food Supply Planning Guidance and Toolkit" includes the following:

- Planning guidelines and assumptions, regulatory references, and other resources intended to support planning efforts
- An Emergency Food Planning Calculation Tool which enables users to calculate facility-specific plans by inputting facility-specific data
- Instructional Power Point presentation
- Video presentation (which incorporates the PowerPoint)
