

Active Shooter Emergency Response Patient Role & Action

Actor 1: _____

Clothing: patient gown, bathrobe, walker, ID tag says ACTOR

Description: Portray elderly female (86 yr), bent over, shuffles, and walks into hall using walker. Slow difficult movements. Hears commotion and eventually sees shooter. Leans against walker, tries to cover face, says repeatedly “what– what”, cowers against wall or walker. Looks confused.

Woman continues to move down hall or toward a closed patient room but cannot get in to space.

Shooter bypasses the patient a number of times. Eventually shoots woman in shoulder - non fatal)

Elderly woman slumps to floor. (Actor -Pulls walker down next to her – *keep out of footpath* lean against the wall.)

Actor: Moan or murmur. You have been shot in the right shoulder so leave one arm hanging.

Site: SCVC 3rd floor, Unit B floor

Method: Act in each rotation. Repeat same acting in each side of hall in each of three sessions (total scene repeated 6 times)

Date/time: Tuesday, March 1, 2011 - during exercise play

Role: Patient (Actor)
