Active Shooter Emergency Response Patient Role & Action

Actor 2: _____

Clothing: patient gown, head dressing (gauze wrap), IV, service dog. ID tag says ACTOR

Description: female (45 yr). Head injury, confused, very poor eyesight and has small service dog named: "HARRY".

In bed, very verbal and confused. Calls out frequently for nurse in **Spanish.** Calling for pain medication. Calling out "I need to go to the bathroom" – "Please hurry – I need to go now!" "Nurse- I need pain medicine." "Call the doctor." Quiet for 30 seconds of so and repeat cycle. Call out "Where's HARRY? - HARRY – HARRY – COME HERE BOY" GOOD BOY – HARRY?

Hears commotion and gunshots. Still calling out as above.

Shooter comes in room – aims BUT does not shoot. Leaves room and later comes back and shoots patient and HARRY.

Actor: Spanish speaker, confused, sight impaired, uses service dog "HARRY". After ACTOR is shot – moan a couple of times and become still. Turn HARRY upside down so his legs are up in the air on patient bed.

Site: SCVC 3rd floor, Unit B floor

Method: Act in each rotation. Repeat same acting in each side of hall in each of three sessions (total scene repeated 6 times). Spanish speaker.

Date/time: Tuesday, March 1, 2011 - during exercise play

Role: Patient (Actor)
