Active Shooter Emergency Response Patient Role & Action

Actor	4:	

Clothing: patient gown or shirt, hand wrapped (gauze wrap) from injury incurred in recent fall during a seizure. Patient disheveled, backpack on ambulance gurney. ID tag says ACTOR

Description: male (50 yr) patient transfer from a treatment program via Pacific Ambulance (PA). Direct admit to the floor for work-up. Probable neurological problem with increasing agitation, seizures, and now difficulty with walking. Will be seen by neuro and neuro surgery services. Pushed into nursing unit on ambulance by PA EMTs, who are not actors but participants in exercise. EMTs announce at Nurse's Station, they have transfer patient from "New Life Treatment Center."

Actor: intermittently calling out to people he sees – "Hey - what's going... down?" "Hey." Stage seizure activity on gurney after minute of so of gunshots and commotion. Look dazed. DO NOT get off the gurney. If the players move the gurney or take you somewhere else – call out again "Hey - what's going... down?" "Hey"

Hears commotion and gunshots. Still calling out as above. Shooter will shot you at some point – be still.

Actor: Disheveled, unable to walk, bit agitated, calls out, and demonstrates seizure activity. Dies.

Site: SCVC 3rd floor, Unit B floor

Method: Act in each rotation. Repeat same acting in each side of hall in each of three sessions (total scene repeated 6 times).

Date/time: Tuesday, March 1, 2011 - during exercise play

Role: Patient (Actor)
